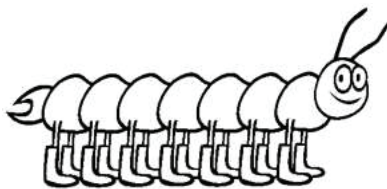


Home Run For Kids Family Day at Chase Field
